# Proportionate Approach To Technology appraisals (PATT)



Supporting access

NICE appraises all new medicines and indications



Increasing demand

No. of appraisals per year is anticipated to grow (reflecting increased no. of marketing authorisations)



Capacity constraints

Across patient and carer groups, academic groups and committees, clinicians, industry and NICE

How can we best use our time, and our stakeholders' time, to support rapid access to innovative medicines?

# PATT workstreams

PATT 1.0

'22 to '23



**Streamlined** - simplified decision-making for next-in-class medicines



**Operational efficiencies** - improving operations by aligning similar appraisals, optimising tech engagement and improving transparency



**Pathways** - single core model for medicines across a whole disease pathway

PATT 2.0

'23 to '24



**High-value steps** - continuing to identify opportunities to make the appraisal process more efficient whilst maintaining the robustness and rigour of the process



**Multi indication products** - efficiencies in appraising multiple indications of a technology



**Rapid entry to managed access** - exploring how NICE could potentially enable earlier patient access to the most promising new technologies, while ensuring value to taxpayers

# Implementing PATT (1.0)



## Streamlining

Simplifying decision-making for next-in-class and other lower-risk medicines.



## Operating efficiently

Improving operations by aligning similar appraisals, optimising tech engagement and improving transparency.



Interim statement released in April 2023.

- Topics that started from April 2023 used the interim statement.



Public consultation on modular update held June – July 2023.

- 1<sup>st</sup> modular update to the 2022 guide to technology evaluation.
- Largely positive response.



Formally published on 31 October 2023.
